Will NYC Set the Pace for Municipal Vehicle Electrification?

ZEV for NYC Act

- History: Council Member Powers introduced Int. 0279-2022 in April 2022
- O Bill elements:
 - NYC must convert its entire fleet, light-duty, medium-duty, heavy-duty vehicles, to ZEVs by July 1, 2035.
 - NYC must start purchasing only light-duty and medium-duty ZEVs by July 1, 2025.
 - NYC must start purchasing only heavy-duty ZEVs by July 1, 2030.
 - Although school buses can be either medium-duty or heavy-duty vehicles, the July 1, 2025, deadline applies to all school buses.
 - Escape clause administrators can purchase the next least polluting option in a vehicle category rather than ZEVs under certain conditions.

New news

(since Dec. 15 NYC Council hearing)

 ICCT's December 20, 2022, report: "Real World Usage of Plug-in Hybrid Vehicles in the U.S."

PHEVs spend 26-56% less time in all-electric drive mode ("utility factor"), and therefore consume 42-67% more fuel than EPA labeling suggests.



Every 20 ZEVs per 1,000 people in a given zip code led to a 3.2% percent drop in the rate of emergency room visits due to asthma.


California plug-in vehicle market share



New York plug-in vehicle adoption



What can you do?

New York State is far behind California:

- In 2022, NYS's plug-in market share was < 1% [estimated].
- In 2022, NYS' plug-in vehicle sales were only 13% of California's [44,000/345,818].
- NYS ranks 12th in plug-ins per 1,000 light duty vehicles.
